The grounds and gardens are tranquil and well-maintained, allowing residents to enjoy the benefits of being outside safely and comfortably.

Our rooms

We try to make our rooms as homely as we can and where possible encourage residents to bring some personal items to remind them of home. Our rooms have en-suite facilities and a nurse call system.

We also offer a TV point in each bedroom, WiFi is available and there is the option to install Sky TV and your own phone line (these last two are at your own cost).





Activities

Our teams listen to the needs of each resident to ensure that they are always content and comfortable. Our activities coordinator organises a weekly schedule of pastimes and entertainment to keep life fun and engaging for everyone.

We look forward to resuming the many activities our residents enjoyed before Covid-19.

The care home has fantastic links with various groups in the community including churches, schools and nurseries.

Residents are able to explore the local community and beyond through trips and excursions in our own minibus.

Staff are extremely welcoming, taking great pride in providing the highest level of care. There are always lots of activities to entertain residents and improve their wellbeing, taking place in communal areas which been recently refurbished.

Simple pleasures, such as reading the morning newspaper or going for a walk in our beautiful grounds, can be just as important for residents. Whether you enjoy flower arranging, painting or a game of cards there is always something to do and somewhere to socialise.

We encourage participation in a range of daily activities, while remaining respectful and reflective of the overall wellbeing and interests of each person living with us.
