All rooms have en-suite WC, or full en-suite facilities. There are a number of comfortable lounges and dining rooms, all of which are well-appointed and offer the opportunity for residents to socialise with ease.

The home benefits from landscaped grounds including patios and courtyard spaces so that residents can enjoy sheltered outdoor areas.

Our rooms

We try to make our rooms as homely as we can and where possible encourage residents to bring some personal items to remind them of home. Our rooms have ensuite facilities and a nurse call system.

We also offer a TV point in each bedroom, WiFi is available and there is the option to install Sky TV and your own phone line (these last two are at your own cost).





Activities

Our teams listen to the needs of each resident to ensure that they are always content and comfortable. Our activities coordinator organises a weekly schedule of pastimes and entertainment to keep life fun and engaging for everyone.

We look forward to resuming the many activities our residents enjoyed before Covid-19, where musicians and even therapy ponies entertained us. Residents were often joined by the local Brownies and welcomed students from nearby schools who volunteer at the home as part of their Duke of Edinburgh Award scheme and also visits from the local primary school.

Simple pleasures, such as reading the morning newspaper or going for a walk in our beautiful grounds, can be just as important for residents. Whether you enjoy flower arranging, painting or a game of cards there is always something to do and somewhere to socialise.

We encourage participation in a range of daily activities, while remaining respectful and reflective of the overall wellbeing and interests of each person living with us.

Food

We take it to heart that good food can be a highlight of the day. Our chef takes great pride in creating enjoyable and nutritionally balanced meals. We make sure we understand your food preferences and, where required, provide assistance with eating.

We provide three meals a day, with snacks in between and we do everything we can to cater for individual likes and tastes.
